



# MEDICAL CORPS AS 'M' CADET



## QUALIFICATION

4<sup>th</sup> / Final Year MBBS Students of PMC recognised med colleges

## CATEGORY OF SELECTION

### 'M' Cadet

1. After enrolment as 'M' Cadet, students will continue to study in their respective Medical College till completion of Medical graduation.
2. On the successful completion of his Medical education and basic military training, 'M' Cadet will be commissioned in the Army Medical Corps as Captain.

## STIPEND

3. Selected 'M' Cadets will be entitled to receive Rs. 18,583/- as monthly stipend.
4. After getting commission in Army Medical Corps as Captain, 'M' Cadets will be entitled to receive lump sum amount not exceeding Rs. 222,996/- per annum as re-imbursment of expenditures occurred on their Medical education prior to joining the scheme.

## 1. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

- ▶ **Age (as on 25<sup>th</sup> July 2021):** 20 to 26 Years
- ▶ **Gender:** Male
- ▶ **Marital Status:** Unmarried
- ▶ **Nationality:** Citizen of Pakistan and domicile holders of Azad Kashmir / Gilgit Baltistan. Upon final selection, candidates with dual nationality will have to surrender nationalities other than Pakistani
- ▶ **Physical Standards**
  - a. Minimum Height: 5'-4" or (162.5 cm)
  - b. Weight: As per Body Mass Index

## 2. INELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

- A candidate is ineligible if he is:-
- a. Twice rejected by ISSB for Post Graduate Entry.
  - b. Twice rejected by ISSB for Intermediate / Graduate (PMA/Graduate/Equivalent) and once rejected by ISSB or GHQ/NHQ/AHQ based selection boards.
  - c. Once rejected by ISSB for Intermediate / Graduate (PMA/Graduate/Equivalent) and twice rejected by ISSB or GHQ / NHQ / AHQ based selection boards.
  - d. Twice not recommended for 'M' Cadet by GHQ / AHQ / NHQ Selection Boards.
  - e. Twice screened out by ISSB.
  - f. Dismissed / removed / debarred from Govt Services including Armed Forces.
  - g. Convicted in a Court of Law for any heinous offence (to be ascertained by competent military authority).
  - h. Permanently declared UNFIT by Appeal Medical Board (AMB).
  - i. Declared medically unfit due to Hepatitis B&C. Appeal Medical Board cannot be requested.
  - j. Withdrawn from any bonded Armed Forces college / institution on disciplinary grounds.
  - k. Withdrawn / discharged / resigned or purchase of commission from any Armed Forces Academy / Training Institution of Armed Forces on any ground.
  - l. Tampering of academic certificates / forgery / concealment to get undue advantage will make an applicant permanently ineligible for all types of commission in Armed Forces.

## 3. REGISTRATION AND PRELIMINARY SELECTION PROCEDURE

Candidates can register either through internet on website: [www.joinpakarmy.gov.pk](http://www.joinpakarmy.gov.pk) or by visiting nearest Army Selection and Recruitment Centers (AS&RCs).

### a. REGISTRATION AT ARMY SELECTION AND RECRUITMENT CENTRES (AS&RCs)

### ▶ REGISTRATION THROUGH INTERNET

Date and time of test shall be intimated on internet, for which the individual should have an e-mail account. Candidates will report on exact date and time given for preliminary test on computerized roll no slip. Date once given will not be changed. Candidates will bring along documents mentioned in para 4. Candidates must attain working knowledge of computer as registration and test will be conducted on computers.

### b. SCHEDULE OF REGISTRATION / PRELIMINARY TESTS

Registration and Preliminary Tests will be held as per the following schedule:-

## ▶ PHYSICAL TEST

- (1) 1.6 KM run - 8 1/2 minutes
- (2) Push Ups - 15 repetitions in 2 minutes
- (3) Sits Ups - 15 repetitions in 2 minutes
- (4) Chin Ups - 3 repetitions in 2 minutes
- (5) Ditch Crossing - 7'.4" x 7'.4" with a depth of 4 feet

## c. PRELIMINARY MEDICAL TEST

Initial medical test at AS&RCs.

## 4. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT AS&RCs

- (1) 2 x attested photocopies of educational and domicile certificates.
- (2) 2 x attested photocopies of Computerized National Identity Card or Form 'B' of individual and his next of kin issued by NADRA.
- (3) 4 x attested passport size photographs.
- (4) Candidates will deposit pay order of Rs. 500/- clearly indicating 'Payable at any Branch in Pakistan' in favour of Surgeon General/ DGMS (IS), Medical Directorate / DMS-1, GHQ Rawalpindi.

## 5. FURTHER SELECTION

Shortlisted candidates will receive notice for intelligence / personality tests by AS&RCs and interviews by the GHQ Selection Board at their nearest stations through website / call up letter. Medical Fitness of candidates who are selected in the final interview shall be carried out at nearest CMHs. Final selection will be made at GHQ on the basis of candidate's overall performance.

On the successful completion of his Medical education and due satisfaction of other requirements of the Scheme, 'M' Cadet will be commissioned in the Army Medical Corps as Captain.

## 6. BASIC MILITARY TRAINING

22 x weeks Basic Military Training (BMT) at Pakistan Military Academy, Abbottabad within one month after MBBS and induction as Short Service Regular Commission (SSRC) Officer by GHQ PA Directorate

## 7. BOND

Finally selected candidates will be required to sign a bond to serve the Army Medical Corps for a minimum of six years, after passing the MBBS.
